CTETE Application for Annual Conference Participation

83rd Annual Conference—Denver, Colorado

March 24-27, 2021

The **COUNCIL ON TECHNOLOGY AND ENGINEERING TEACHER EDUCATION** will sponsor three types of special interest sessions at the annual ITEEA Conference:

(1) Paper/Research presentations (blind reviewed),

These are designed to be presentations of well-formulated studies that present data, results, and conclusions. Presenters in this category will be first asked to submit a short abstract on their topic for review by the committee. Those whose abstracts are accepted will be asked to develop a full paper on their topic. All papers submitted in this category will be peer reviewed by members of CTETE. All accepted papers in this category will be published in the CTETE Conference Proceedings (authors retain the copyrights). The conference proceedings will be electronically published and made available.

(2) General Conference sessions (peer reviewed),

These are designed to allow presenters an opportunity to share a synopsis of their current work. These topics may include preliminary findings of a study, an overview of a current project, a collection of resources, etc.

(3) Poster presentations (peer reviewed).

These allow for presenters to display their work in a setting that encourages discussion and interaction. The poster presentations are scheduled for a 2-hour time slot. Please note that poster presentation descriptions are NOT printed in the conference program, only title and presenter names.

Notes

- At the time of application, all presenters and co-presenters must be ITEEA Professional Members through the end of the conference. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the cancellation of your session.
- All presenters and co-presenters must be fully preregistered for the conference by **December 1, 2021**. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the cancellation of your session.
- ITEEA/CTETE does not provide honorariums or cover travel, registration fees, conference expenses, etc.
- Please note that AV equipment other than a projection surface/screen is NOT provided.
