Lunch in the Exhibit Hall on Friday, April 14 at 12:30pm CT

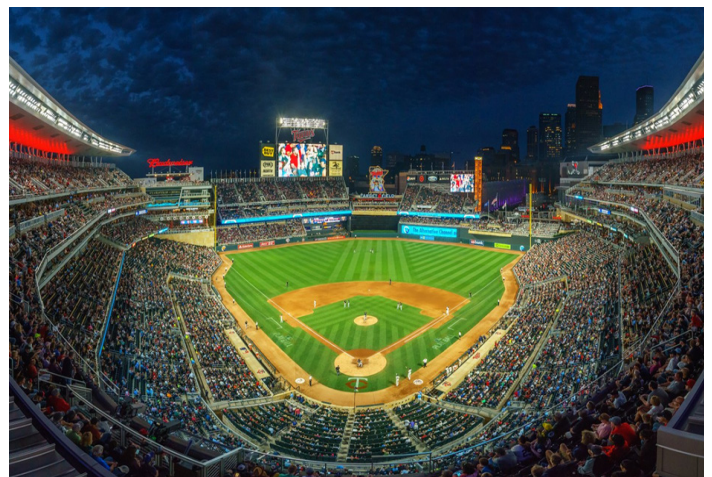
